

Minutes of the Capitol View Park Citizens Association

Old Business

New Business

A motion was made & seconded to add the Montgomery County Police sex offender's information website to CVPCA's website, newsletter, & directory to encourage CVP residents to apprise themselves of such people in our community.

Leafy House: To raise money, they have invited CVPCA to participate in a bazaar they will be holding sometime in March, April, or May. Additionally, on February 14 there will be a 50/50 raffle. Tickets are \$1/ person.

It was also reported that Leafy house is being sold to Victory Housing (Victoryhousing.org).

BRAC report: Because of the impact on communities in the area, CKC sent a letter opposing Navy's construction plan at Rockville Pike & Cedar Lane. Sheila reports that State Legislator Richard Madaleno will attend the next CKC meeting on January 24 at which time he is asking community members to make suggestions on how to mitigate the traffic problems that will develop with Navy's projected 2000 new employees & some 30,000 new persons using the roads in this area. County Council Executive Isiah Leggett has appointed a person to handle BRAC issues.

Sligo Creek golf course project: A letter from a Kensington couple was circulated among board members regarding MC Revenue Authority's proposal to implement its Golf Master Plan for Sligo Creek.
