Currently, traffic is moving along well over the 25 mph speed limit during many times of the day & evening hours. Betsy will write a letter to State Representative Al Carr itemizing our recommendations.

NEW BUSINESS

- Progressive Dinner June 7: CVPCA's social director, Kit Wood, will be hired to prepare the food. Tickets for the event will cost \$40.
- Illegal dumping at 20240 CVA: A motion was made & seconded that Carol will report it in a letter to DEP with a copy to HPC.
- Shed imbedded in fence on Stoneybrook: Carol will check on, then report to us about this structure on property located near the bridge over the railroad tracks by the CVP sign.
- Funds for plants by CVP entrance sign on CVA: Carol suggested that the Historic Society gift of \$200 to CVPCA from last year's progressive meal be used to replace expired plants.
